Students in Years 3-6 have the opportunity to take place in the Arts Unit's annual *Multicultural Perspectives Public Speaking* competition. Each student will participate by writing and presenting a speech for the competition, however, it will be a personal choice if they wish to enter the competition and progress beyond the classroom activity. Classes will hold their class finals by **Friday, May 31** with the Merimbula Public School final to be held on **Wednesday, June 5.** The top two speakers from each stage will be invited to the local final (venue/date TBA - from week 7 to 10 in Term 2). Participants who progress in the competition will need to present one prepared and one impromptu speech.

Students will begin writing their speech in class and will complete them at home. The attachment provided explains the competition in detail.
