Over the course of 5 weeks, our Koori students have participated in the 'Garrijimanha' program, writing and creating a song. As part of the program, students have been able to creatively share their stories and culture through music, encouraging them to feel empowered in their own identity.

Our students have been offered the unique opportunity to record the track professionally at the *Merimbula School of Music* supported by program coordinator Chelsy Atkins and sound engineer Ricky Bloomfield.

A supervising teacher will accompany the students to walk to Merimbula School of Music at 9:00am on Tuesday 10th and Wednesday 11th of December. They will return to school at an estimated time of 11.30am on Tuesday and 2.45pm on Wednesday.

Students will need to wear school uniform, a broad brim hat, suitable walking shoes, and have a bottle of water to take. They will also need to bring their own lunch and recess.
