

GRADUATION CEREMONY ORGANISATION

Friday, November 13, 2020.

Dear Parents and Carers,

On November 5, the Department of Education shared that Graduation Ceremonies can go ahead, with parents in attendance, as long as the school has a COVID-Safe plan and adheres to the NSW Health 4 square metre rule guidelines, as well as, that all adults from different households are 1.5m apart at all times. These guidelines also require student numbers to be included in the 4 square metre rule when parents/site guests are present. As a result, whilst parents will be invited on to the site, as we would love to have as many guests as safely possible, we will have strict number capacities. This will be explained below. We aim to support parent attendance as best as possible, in accord with the restrictions and following health advice. Some seats will be out of the hall, in the Covered Outdoor Learning Area (COLA).

Capacity of Hall (adhering to the 4 square metre rule) including students/staff/stage/presenters = 72 people.

Capacity of COLA (adhering to restrictions also) = 25 people.

Therefore we can have a **maximum of 97** in attendance (including staff and students).

As you can see, a lot of planning and adjustments go into every event at Merimbula Public School, particularly when ensuring we adhere to COVID-Safe/NSW Health Guidelines. We are so fortunate to be experiencing good COVID-health across our region/state, to allow these guidelines to be put in place so that some parents/caregivers can attend our graduation events. Please be advised though, that this is the 'best case scenario' at this time. Should there be a COVID case at Merimbula Public School, in the township of Merimbula, or where students have been on camp in recent weeks, or if NSW Health/Department advice changes, we may advise at short notice that parents/caregivers/whole classes are no longer permitted to attend. If this is the case, we will endeavour to photograph/film all events, where students have permission to publish.





Further to this, parents attending will need to have their 'ticket', which will be received after the attached slip has been returned to school. Subsequent tickets for students in shared care arrangements, may be held until after enough tickets become available. Please ensure that you return this acknowledgement slip before the due date of Monday, November 23 so that your ticket is not reallocated.

Parents/caregivers with tickets who are attending the event, must be free of any flu-like symptoms. Parents/caregivers who present as unwell at any graduation event, will be excluded from attending subsequent events until they are showing no symptoms and have provided the school with a negative COVID-test result. Ticket holders will be provided with a *Visitor's Declaration* to sign and hand in with their ticket on arrival at school. Parents/caregivers without tickets, or who refuse to complete a declaration, will not be permitted on site. No late tickets will be handed out. No tickets will be handed out on the day, or after Week 7. Please support us to support you, and make this event a success by adhering to these guidelines.

Information about access to the hall, seating arrangements and other COVID-safe event measures, will be provided to ticket holders during Week 7 of this term (the week commencing Monday, November 23). This will be when parents/caregivers receive tickets.

Please be advised that, due to the strict NSW Health guidelines and capacity requirements, siblings, toddlers, infants, babies and other guests will not be able to attend the ceremonies. This means that if you have a baby, unfortunately they cannot attend, even if they are in a pram/seated on a lap. ONLY people who arrive with a ticket will be let in.

Please find below the acceptance slip for you/a parent/caregiver to attend your child's Graduation Ceremony, which will include his/her yearly Presentation Day Award Ceremony. If you cannot attend, please let us know in the slip, so that additional parents/caregivers can be included if a student lives within a shared care arrangement.
