Dear Parents and Carers,

We are so excited to be able to have parents and caregivers attend our Graduation Ceremonies!

Thank you for sending in a request for a ticket, so that you can attend a Graduation Ceremony.

Please find attached your [entry ticket](#). **You will require this to enter the hall.**

On the back of this note is a [Visitor Declaration](#). Please complete the form **ON THE DAY OF THE GRADUATION**, before you come onto the school site. You will need to hand it in at the JACKSON HALL gate, before entering the grounds. Please **ONLY** use this gate. **No Visitor Declaration/no ticket = no entry.**

As shared in last fortnight's information note, as of November 5, the Department of Education shared that Graduation Day and end-of-year Presentation Day events can go ahead, with parents in attendance, as long as the school has a COVID-Safe plan and adheres to the NSW Health 4 square metre rule guidelines, as well as, that all adults from different households are 1.5m apart at all times. These guidelines also require student numbers to be included in the 4 square metre rule. We have adhered to these rules. **All tickets are numbered and seats are designated. EG: Ticket # R1/S5 = Row 1 Seat 5. You will be shown to your seat on arrival at the hall. Please support our COVID-Safe Plan and do not mingle with other visitors, get within 1.5m of any staff, students or other visitors. Visitors cannot move chairs/seats. You will also need to sanitise your hands on arrival. If these protocols are not followed, you will not be permitted entry.** If you have any questions about these procedures, please contact me at school on (02) 64951266 or via email.

- **The gate will not open until 11.30am.** Please be aware of parking restrictions and maintain your 1.5m distancing when in parking/out of school areas & when lining up. **Graduations begin on 12 noon.**
- No late entries into the hall/COLA, or early exits, will be permitted. This will ensure people are not coming within 1.5m of one another. *Please keep your distance if moving around to use the bathroom. Adults are to use the hall toilets, inside the Jackson Hall. Students will not use these.*
- **We are happy for you to FILM/PHOTOGRAPH the show. However....**some students do not have permission to publish. Therefore, **ONLY** photograph/record your own child.
- Guests are not to come if they are unwell.
- **Any changes to procedures/access will be announced on Facebook and via School Stream.**
