Classes Commence – 8.55am


Fruit / Crunch and Sip Break – Between 9am and 10.30am

## Day 1 of School Information – January 29, 2021

- Currently, parents/caregivers are **not permitted on site** at NSW public schools (unless in specific situations, with COVID-Safe plans, *like at our Graduation events etc*).
- On Day 1 of Term 1, January 29, parents/caregivers will still not be permitted on site.
- **Kindergarten students** will enter the school grounds with all other students, unless entering with a parent during their **'Staggered Start' time.** Times have already been provided. If you have misplaced your letter, please contact the office on Thursday, January 28. Parents taking their child to their classroom, during the 'Staggered Start' must enter via the front gate, sanitise and sign a Visitor Declaration Form at the office.
- If the Department of Education changes information regarding pick-up and drop-offs, information will be shared via Facebook and School Stream. Should this be the case, we will still have to follow the Department's COVID-Safe requirements, which requires a *limit to outdoor gatherings of 50 people (including staff/parents/students)*. As a result, even if we are permitted to allow parents on-site for Day 1 pick-up, this will only be for the parents of Kindergarten students and our new enrolments (and not all at once due to the 50 person max.). 2020 parents/Year 1-6 students will use the front school gate for pick-up as per current arrangements. We will confirm what will be happening on Facebook. The pick-up area for Kindy/new students will be at the back gate, either outside if no entry is permitted, or on the oval if onsite pick-ups are permitted giving parents room to physically distance 1.5m from one-another/students. For the first 4 weeks, the back gate will be open for Kindy/new student pick up from 2.45pm, with the Kindy classes being in that area. From March, the gate will be opened by the duty teacher, once their class has left their classroom (after the 2.55pm bell). Parents/caregivers of Kindergarten students/new enrolments should not go to other areas in the school/classrooms as this will not comply with the 1.5m distancing rule. Our paths are not that wide. More information about changes to COVID-safe rules and parent/carer participation will be shared in the first week of Term 1.
