Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Our Stage 2 Athletics Carnival is taking place next **Wednesday, June 9 throughout the day, at Merimbula Public School**. Parents, Caregivers, Grandparents and friends are invited to attend. If it is raining on Wednesday, we will be re-scheduling the carnival to *Thursday, June 17*. Times will be the same.

Parking/Entry: Visitors must enter/exit via the Administration Office Gate on Randolph Street, throughout the carnival. The Henwood Street (Oval) gate will not be open.

Visitors will ALSO need to sign in at the gate using their smart device/our QR Code.

You will ALSO need to Log-In using the Visitor's Log.

We have included our **QR Code** on this invitation so that you can sign in **before** you get to the gate. **You will need to show your device/log-in to the staff member at the gate.** As shared, Parents/Caregivers/Guests will ALSO need to complete the Visitor's Log Book. Entry will also mean you give us permission to take/publish photographs of you during the event and that you will adhere to the Department of Education's Code of Conduct.

If parents/carers/visitors attend, please move to a seating area and remain seated for the duration of the carnival.

COVID-19 Requirements for Visitors: Guests/visitors must:

- Be **free of flu-like symptoms**.
- **Sanitise on arrival.**
- Use the disabled toilet outside the hall (and sanitise after using bathroom spaces).
- Remain in a **seating area** throughout the event, do not visit students/staff. There will be a range of seating areas on the day to choose from.
- Maintain **1.5m distance from all staff/students/guests** at all times.
- **Only take/publish photos of their own child.**
- Not attend if they are awaiting COVID-19 results, or are required to stay at home, in accord NSW Health Requirements.
- Ensure that their child does not attend the carnival if unwell/awaiting COVID-19 results.
- **Leave the grounds during our recess break** between 1.15pm and 1.55pm. If returning, they will need to **QR Code and sign in again.**
- **Keep up to date with any changes to requirements/event times on Facebook.**
