Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Our Easter Hat and Hair Parade is taking place next **Wednesday, March 31**. Students are welcome to:

- 1. Wear mufti clothing;
- 2. Wear an Easter Hat, bonnet or hairstyle created at home;
- 3. Invite parents/caregivers/siblings to attend (weather permitting).

If it is raining next Wednesday, we will still be holding our parade. Unfortunately, we will not have the capacity to invite parents/caregivers if raining, as our hall will not seat additional visitors in a COVID-Safe physically distanced way. If it rains, we will Live Stream the parade on Facebook. Students without permission to publish will parade before the streaming commences. If the weather permits, parents/caregivers are welcome to attend. We have included our **QR Code** on this page so that you can sign in **before** you get to the gate. As an alternative to completing the Visitor's Log Book, and to save time/queues, you can hand in your Attendance Slip (below). We will complete your 'log in' for you. If you do not bring your slip, you will need to sign in at the gate. Entry will also mean you give us permission to take/publish photographs of you during the event. **If parents/carers attend, please only take/share photos of your own child.** 

Seats will be limited. Guests will receive seats on a 'first in' basis. We will put out as many chairs as we are able to on the day. We hope that nobody misses out. Guests coming for the parade will have to stay for the duration of the parade and will need to remain seated.

#### COVID-19 Requirements for Visitors/Contractors/Providers:

- Guests/students/staff are to be free of flu-like symptoms & are to sanitise on arrival
- Guests are to use the disabled toilet outside the hall or hall toilets (and sanitise after using bathroom spaces)
- Guests must remain seated throughout the event, do not visit students/staff and maintain 1.5m distance to all staff/students/guests that they do not live with at all times.
