As shared last night via School Stream and our website, our staff have prepared another *Learning from Home* work booklet for your child, should *Learning from Home* continue again next week. The booklet is enclosed in this envelope (fingers crossed your child won't have to use it!). Staff will continue to communicate via Class Dojo messenger each day next week, should *Learning from Home* continue, to let you know of your child's class tasks for the day. - **Every Monday between 9.30am and 2.30pm** (when the bus zone is not in operation).

If Learning from Home does continue, we would like to know your thoughts about completing online learning as opposed to, or in addition to, paper-based work tasks. Please complete the survey attached and return it to school via email, as a scanned document, or via the drop box with your child's work. This way, should Learning from Home continue beyond three weeks, we can consider your family's most appropriate and chosen method of completing tasks, and make changes if required in moving forward.

Thank you once again for your collaboration and support during this trying time. Thank you also for keeping our community and your children as safe as possible at this time, by supporting your child in *Learning from Home* unless they need to be at school (due to you being an essential/critical worker). We had less than 10 students at school today, which is a great start in keeping our community, school community, students, families and staff safe.
