



Classic Shield Rugby League Knockout Competition 2021

Dear Parents/Carers,

The PSSA Classic Shield Rugby League State Knockout Competition will be held on **Thursday, 27th May 2021 at Pambula Sports Ground**. This year we are covering the first few rounds of the competition in a gala day format, run by the CRL. This means that our teams will get at least 2 games. If they are the winners on the day, they will progress to the next round against other South Coast regional teams. Your child has been selected to represent Merimbula Public School in this competition.

Players will need to provide their own boots. Mouthguards are compulsory and headgear is highly recommended. Your child will also need a broad brimmed hat, sunscreen and a water bottle. Students wearing shoulder pads must wear official and approved rugby league pads. Students with Asthma/anaphylaxis/medication must have provided such to the school, with their Action Plan.

A copy of the draw will be given to students when all schools have confirmed entry and when the draw has been published. Game times will be included in the draw. It is anticipated that students will be at the ground from 9.15am to 2.30pm (TBC). Students are to meet Mr Morris at the ground, 45 minutes prior to our first game, to collect their uniform and warm up. Confirmation of times will be shared when we have them (via Facebook).

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, parents/caregivers will need to maintain 1.5m of physical distancing at all times, and sign in using the QR Code at the ground. Spectators are welcome.
