Semester 1 SRC Celebration Disco – Let's Dance Again!!!

Dear Parents/Caregivers/Grandparents,

The School Representative Council (SRC) will be holding a non-compulsory disco in the Jackson Hall on **Wednesday night, March 24. The cost for each student is \$8**, which includes water, a snack (popcorn or a small chips) and fruit. All funds raised will go towards Lego Robotics kits for the school.

The theme for the **Kindergarten to Year 2 disco will be "Sports"** (No crop tops, high heels, thongs or singlet tops) and it will take place from **5:00pm until 6:25pm**.

The theme for the **Year 3 to Year 6 disco will be "Fluro / Neon*** (No crop tops, high heels, thongs or singlet tops) and will be held from **6:30pm until 8:00pm**. The 5 school leaders will need to be at school at 4:30pm to set up with Ms Hulme, Mrs Kirk and Mr Doherty.

During the Disco, children will be expected to adhere to the school rules. If a child is on a Behaviour Monitoring on the day of the disco, or has been suspended during the past 10 school weeks, they are not permitted to attend. If a child is absent from school on the day of the disco, they are not permitted to attend. Children with broken limbs are encouraged not to attend in the interest of their safety, or are to see their child's classroom teacher to discuss safety measures. Students who require asthma puffers/EpiPen's should bring one with them, if they do not already have one at school.

Drop-Off and Pick-Up Procedures:

- Students are to be dropped off by a parent/caregiver to the Jackson Hall. A teacher will be at the hall gate, so children can be brought to the gate. Children will then sign in at the sign-in table, supported by staff.
- Should a parent wish to bring his/her child on site, they must use the QR Code to sign in, as well as complete the Visitor Log. Parents/caregivers will not be permitted to stay for the duration of the disco. They will need to leave after 5 minutes, to support physical distancing/space requirements. Therefore it may be easier to drop your child at the gate.
- When each disco is finished, students will be walked by staff to the lower Covered Outdoor Learning Area (COLA). This will give us more space for parents to come on site and collect their child. This will be familiar to the children also, as it is our new Years 1-6 and Wet Weather Pick-Up Area.
- When collecting your child after the disco/s, you will need to enter the school via the Office Gate. You will also need to use the QR Code to sign in, as well as, complete the Visitor Log sign in.
- If your child is being collected by someone else on the night, you will have to indicate such on the permission note below.
- Please do not come on site if you are displaying any flu-like symptoms.
- Parents are requested to pick up their children promptly.

Please complete the permission note below and return it to school by *Monday, March 22.* All payments must be made online using the 'Make a Payment' portal at https://merimbula-p.schools.nsw.gov.au/ PRIOR TO MONDAY, MARCH 22. Late payment/notes will not be accepted.
