

Year 6 Excursion Survey - 2021

Friday, February 5, 2021.

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

We are so excited to be able to offer our Year 6 students the opportunity to go on a Year 6 Camp in 2021 (at this point in time!). As shared in 2020, we have tentatively booked two different Year 6 Camps so that parents can have input into where our children go.

Option 1: Sydney Camp – Term 1 WEEK 8 (in 6 weeks): Tuesday, March 16 – Friday, March 19 (4 days/3 nights)

- \$600 per child. (\$100 deposit due February 19, \$200 due by March 12, final \$300 due by the end of Term 2, which is after the excursion *We would love full payment prior for those who can pay, but with the short turn around we will offer a late payment. Please be advised, if one does not pay the final payment by the end of Term 2, their child will not be able to attend other events/Year 6 Farewell/other paid or extra-curricular events until the final payment is met). Some/all funds may be forfeited should COVID restrictions require the excursion to be cancelled and the school is not refunded deposits/full payment. This excursion is subsidised by the school already. All payments are to be made online via our website.
- Venues include: 1 night at the Taronga Zoo Snooze (with night tour of the zoo!) / 2 nights staying at the YHA in the Rocks.
- Attractions: Taronga Zoo (night walk and meet the keeper day tour), Sydney Eye-Tower, Rocks walking tour, Maritime Museum, Sea Life Aquarium, Chinese Gardens of Friendship, Illawarra Fly Tree Top Walk.
- **Other:** Students to provide own bedding. Meals and bus cost included. Masks may have to be worn in some locations if mandated. Excursion booked early, to be held before the winter flu season. It is not often our children have the opportunity to camp in Taronga Zoo and do a torch tour at night! Approximate 7.5 hour bus trip.

Option 2: Canberra Camp – Term 4 WEEK 9: Monday, November 29 – Wednesday, December 1 (3 days/2 nights)

- **\$370 per child.** (\$100 deposit due February 19, \$100 due June 18, \$100 due September 10, \$70 due October 15). Some/all funds may be forfeited should COVID restrictions require the excursion to be cancelled and the school is not refunded deposits/full payment. All payments are to be made online via our website.
- Venues include: Staying at the Capital Airport Motel Queanbeyan for 2 nights.
- Attractions: National Capital Exhibition, Parliament House, National Museum of Australia, Australian Institute Of Sport, War Memorial, National Film and Sound Archives, Indoor Rock Climbing Centre, Questacon.
- **Other:** Bedding provided. Meals and bus cost included. Masks may have to be worn in some locations if mandated. Closer to home should your child need to be collected by you if they display flu-like symptoms whilst on camp. 3.5 hours drive.

Please consider the above options and let us know which excursion you would like us to book. The excursion will be booked on Monday afternoon, so that we can get the initial notes out next week. Please let us know your preference by returning the slip below, or by messaging your child's classroom teacher via Class Dojo.
