Year 6 'Introduction to Eden Marine High School' Small Group Transition Day

Dear Parents/Carers,

On Thursday, November 11, selected Year 6 students will be attending an "Introduction to High School Day" at Eden Marine High School. This day is designed as an additional, small group introduction to Eden Marine High School for Year 6 students who may feel anxious about the transition. The transition day is to give students the opportunity to gain familiarity with staff, subject faculties, students, as well as, school policies and procedures. By utilising smaller groups (as opposed to the Year 6 Orientation Day when all students are present), we hope students will find the experience less daunting and will be more willing to share their feelings, ask questions and interact with their peers and the wider school community. Students attending the small group transitions, are to also attend the Year 7 Orientation Day on November 23.

Transport to and from the Orientation Day is the responsibility of parents/caregivers. Students may catch their high school bus (please call Sapphire Coast Bus Lines for details on 02 64956452). Alternately, parents/caregivers are required to drop off and pick up students at EMHS. If students display any flu-like symptoms on or during the day of orientation, they will not be permitted to attend and parents will be contacted to pick-up their child.

To support Year 6 students who may benefit from an additional day of transition, Eden Marine High School will provide an additional day of activities on 11 November.

Supporting student wellbeing

The purpose of this day is to provide an opportunity for Year 6 students to become familiar with a much larger school setting and the supports available to them to develop the skills they need to develop self-awareness, manage anxiety and build confidence. Students will meet their Year Adviser and engage in a range of activities. They will also have the opportunity to meet teachers and become familiar with the learning spaces in our school.

Travel arrangements

Students can travel by bus, or with parents and carers to and from Eden Marine High School. The bus travel is free, and the bus companies are aware of the change to the usual travel arrangements of Year 6 students. Students will be at Eden Marine High School for the full school day. Students will be met and welcomed to our school at the front gate. They will also be supported to return to their buses in the afternoon.


Additional Transition Day - uniform
