Championship Information

Championships will commence at 9:00am. The first marshalling call will be at 8:45am. Team Managers need to report by 8.15am. Officials need to report at 8:30am.

- Individual Medley events will be conducted in 2 age divisions Junior (8,9,10yrs) and Senior (11,12/13yrs) for girls and boys. The 9 fastest times submitted by districts for the medley and 100m freestyle will be accepted. Schools will be notified of the fields asap after all entries are received.
- There is no restriction upon the number of events a competitor may enter.
- Events for athletes with a disability (multi-Class events) will be conducted at these championships. Entries should be included on the district shell entries.

Spectators/ livestreaming

Spectators welcome, but we ask they do not congregate on the concrete apron surrounding the pool.

Livestreaming of the South Coast Swimming Championships will be available through the South Coast School Sports Association website https://app.education.nsw.gov.au/sport/SouthCoast

Relay events will be restricted to three heats only- 1st and 2nd place in each district

Students are encouraged to arrive at least 45 minutes before their scheduled race time.

Results will not be posted but will be given to district managers.

Students need to remain in their district areas unless competing.

Wherever possible, students are encouraged to come dressed ready to compete to minimise changeroom use.

Hoodie sales will be online (see below).

Canteen

A canteen service catering for light refreshments will be available (hot dogs, pies, sausage rolls, donuts, drinks etc). Cash only. Students are encouraged to bring their own food and drinks.

Please note there is no ATM at the pool. The closest ATM is located at Dapto Mall.

Shelter

Districts are requested to provide shelter for their students.

Behaviour

- A Code of Behaviour will be on display at the championships. Everybody attending the championships, including spectators, is expected to abide by this. Penalties may apply.
- District team managers are reminded that they are responsible for maintaining good order and discipline. Competitors who misbehave will be omitted from competition.
- The concrete apron surrounding the pool is out of bounds to all but carnival officials.
- The toddler pool is out of bounds for competitors and spectators.
- Loitering in shower/toilet areas is not allowed.
- The recorders' room is out of bounds to all except for carnival officials and district managers.
- All areas that have been fenced off by pool or carnival officials are out of bounds. This is for safety reasons and **must be obeyed**.

Competitors

During these championships, competitors will be selected to represent the South Coast SSA at the NSW PSSA State Swimming Championships to be held at the Sydney Olympic Park Aquatic Centre (SOPAC) on 5 April - 6 April. State information will be handed out on the day.

In 2023, all South Coast athletes will provide their details for parental and school consent through the online Dash platform. It is strongly suggested that you register immediately following the South Coast championships as school approval can take a few days, and the online platform does not allow for late registration or payment. Please contact the office on 4267 6162 if payment is an issue.

Conditions and Instructions

1. Method of starting

Competitors must be placed in their lanes and one-half pace behind the starting position. The Referee will give a long whistle to signal competitors to take their positions on the starting platform and remain there, or for backstroke, to immediately enter the water. On the starters command they shall immediately take up a starting position with at least one foot at the front of the starting platform and **remain stationary** (for backstroke a second long whistle will be sounded to take your position). The position of the hands is not relevant. When all swimmers are stationary, the Starter shall give the starting signal.

The one start rule will apply in all events. Any swimmer starting before the starting signal has been given shall be disqualified and be withdrawn from the event.

2. Protests shall be lodged in writing by the relevant District Team Manager within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the event to the Championship Convener. Team managers will be wearing hi-vis vests with their district name, so they are easily located.

Lodgement by parents will not be accepted.

3. All events will be timed finals. Competitors will be seeded, as per NSW Swimming rules, based on entry times.

Results for each event will be determined by the times achieved in the heats – **there** will be no finals.

- 4. Once competitors are in the hands of officials controlling the event, they are not to receive any coaching or advice. **Penalty: Disqualification.**
- 5. Program

The Championship Convener reserves the right to alter the program if this is deemed necessary.

Program of events- events with times will be available at a later date

- Team Managers to assemble at 8.15am.
- Officials to assemble at 8:30am.
- All events are timed finals there will be no finals conducted for any events.
- All competitors must be marshalled 15 minutes before the scheduled time of the event.
- Junior events are for 8-10yrs, senior 11-13yrs.

Concussion Clearance

Important Information:
