

"Jackson Cup" Soccer and Netball Carnival: Years 3-6

October 13th, 2017

Dear Parents, Caregivers and Grandparents,

The Jackson Cup Soccer and Netball competition has been scheduled for <u>Tuesday, October 31st, 2017</u>. Students in Years 3 to 6 will leave school at **9.05am** and walk to Berrambool Oval to play either soccer or netball*. Students should dress in school sports uniform (house colours) but need to ensure they are being sun smart by wearing a broad brimmed hat, have applied sunscreen and ensure they have a water bottle available. No singlets, muscle T's or midriff tops are to be worn. There will be no lunch orders on the day. Children will need to bring recess but will be provided with a sausage sizzle for lunch. Times for our lunch and recess will be reversed, with students having recess first and lunch later in the day. In the case of inclement weather, a back-up date of Tuesday, November 7 has been set.

For soccer players, shin pads are compulsory and they are encouraged to bring these from home. The school has a limited supply of shin pads that students can borrow and share. Students <u>WILL NOT</u> be permitted to wear soccer boots this year. <u>ALL</u> students will be wearing sneakers. For netball players, fingernails must be short and jewellery (including wristbands) cannot be worn. <u>All students who require asthma medication are required to have this on their person at all times.</u>

The Jackson Cup is about having a go and showing good sportsmanship. Children do not have to be the best player; they are aiming to be the best sport! All children are expected to play unless written permission has been given to their class teacher. All participating students will receive a lemonade icy-twist at the end of the day. Please let your child's teacher know if you do not want your child to receive this.

At the conclusion of the cup, all children will be returning to school for their usual end of day routine. If your child is walking home from Berrambool, written permission will need to be brought to the carnival on the day. Also, if collecting your child from Berrambool, they will need to be signed out from the recording desk at the pavilion.

Kindergarten and Stage 1 students will be participating in their own sports day back at school. Stage 1 teachers will provide more details of the 'K-2 Jackson Cup' day. Parents and caregivers are welcome to attend the Jackson Cup. We look forward to seeing you there! ***Boys and girls have the choice to play either sport.**
