

2018 SCLC Music Camp Acceptance

It is with pleasure that we wish to offer you a place in the 2018 Sapphire Coast Learning Community Music Camp being held from **9am Monday, 28th May – 9.00pm Thursday 31st May 2018 (Week 5, Term 2)**.

Please read the following information carefully and familiarise yourself with the details and expectations of the camp.

- The cost of the camp is **\$290.00** per student (\$190 per subsequent family member).
IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE, FULL PAYMENT AND ALL NOTES MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN FRIDAY 11th MAY 2018.
Please note that there is a waiting list for the camp. If payment is not received on time, students on the waiting list will be offered your child's position. Payment should be made payable to your school. Please submit all permission notes with your payment as they will be collected by your school office and faxed to us.
- The camp is held at Kianinny Resort, Tathra with the majority of rehearsals, workshops and activities conducted on site. Some rehearsals may be held at Tathra Surf Club or Tathra Public School. Travel to these venues will be by bus or private transport with DEC staff.
- Students will be placed in workshops according to their skillset and needs of ensembles. In some cases, if workshops are crowded students will have a chance to nominate another workshop.
- Students will be placed in cabins of up to 8 students. Naturally, male and female students are separated. We try to keep students in school groups and/or with similar age peers. There is an option on the permission form for students to nominate two similar aged peers they would prefer to share with. We will do our best to accommodate requests.
- At the conclusion of the camp, a concert is to be held in the **Tathra Public School Hall. The concert is expected to commence at 7pm and end by approx. 9.00pm.** This performance is free of charge to parents/caregivers of all students attending the camp, however, due to restricted space, each family will be **limited to 2 seats per family. Doors will open at 6.30pm.**
- Students are required to arrive at Kianinny Resort, **246 Tathra Rd, Tathra** at **9am Monday, 28th May** and bring a packed lunch and afternoon tea with them.
- Students will need to be collected at the conclusion of the camp from Tathra Public School, after the concert. All baggage and other equipment will have been transported to the school and can be collected after the concert.
- In cases of emergency the organisers can be contacted during the camp at Kianinny Resort ph. 6494 1990
- While attending the camp, students will be expected to follow all reasonable directions of Kianinny and Music Camp staff and peer mentors. The camp is being organised to provide enjoyment and education for all involved, consequently persistent disobedience or behaviour considered as inappropriate according to DEC policy while at camp may lead to expulsion from camp. In these unexpected and extreme circumstances parents will be contacted and asked to collect their child immediately. The school principal would be contacted and further disciplinary action may be imposed.
- Students will be expected to adhere to their school's policies regarding mobile phones and valuables.
- Kianinny Resort has a range of extracurricular activities in order to include some structured 'down time' if possible. One potential activity being considered is **canoeing**, however, inclusion of this activity is dependant upon the weather and time limits.
- Timetables and other information will be handed to students on the day of arrival.
