Dear Parent/Guardian,

At this stage we have had 44 students pay their \$200 deposit or more for the Years 3-6 Ski/Snow Excursion. This excursion is a memorable part of each child's learning experience and it links to the curriculum. Classes will still operate for those not attending. Students attending the excursion should discuss whether they will have catch up work with their teacher. You may also like to contact your child's class teacher during the week following the excursion, to see if there is anything your child has missed that they may need to follow up on.

We will be taking one bus on the excursion. At this stage, the attending teachers include: Ms Michelle Hulme (Principal), Mr Ben Kirk (3-6 Assistant Principal/Year 5 Teacher), Miss Natasha Sconfienza (Year 4 Teacher) and Mr Craig Morris (Year 6 Teacher).

Failure to make instalments on time may result in your child being placed on a wait list/withdrawn.
- Only paid _____ of the required \$200 excursion cost. Please contact me at school before the end of term to discuss your child's attendance at the excursion as their place may be withdrawn.

*Confirmations may be withdrawn if:

- (a) The excursion is cancelled due to low numbers following subsequent instalments;
- (b) Your child is withdrawn from the excursion due to illness/behaviour (this may result in them forfeiting their \$200 deposit).

If the excursion is cancelled or a student is withdrawn, parents/carers who made the initial payment will receive a refund form. Funds will then be returned to a nominated bank account within 20 business days.
