Dear Parents and Caregivers,

The next game of the Paul Kelly Cup is taking place next Friday, May 31 at Gundary Oval, Moruya.

I have not received a draw as yet, but will hopefully receive it and send it home on Monday. We need to be at Gundary Oval by **9.45am**. With roadworks taking place in some areas, cars should be **leaving Merimbula by 7.15am**.

We will be taking two teams, a mixed team and an all-boys team. Boys may have time playing on either or both teams throughout the day. Team line-ups for the first game have not yet been finalised.

Games will start from 10am. The day will be organised as a knockout, with the finals being played at 1.30pm. Therefore the day should conclude by 2pm. Mr Phil Jackson, Mr Geoff Pursell, Mr Danny Hayes and I will be coaching/supporting the teams on the day. Thank you to Ms Jo Mayer and Mrs Shiomi Blewitt for offering to drive extra children.

Our "Mixed Team" will be in a pool of four teams: Merimbula PS, Cobargo PS, Batemans Bay PS and St Mary's Moruya.

Our "Boys Team" will be in a pool of eight teams: Merimbula PS, Mumbulla School, St Michael's Nowra, Lumen Christi Catholic College, Milton Public School, St Mary's Moruya, Batemans Bay PS and Narooma PS.

There will be no canteen operating on the day. Please ensure that your child/ren packs:

- Fruit break
- Morning tea
- Lunch
- Spending money (in case the driver stops for snacks on the way home etc)
- 2 x water bottles (at least \*\*\*\*some children took NO water to the last knockout day)
- A hat, sunscreen and mat or towel to sit on (for in between games)
- An asthma puffer/Epipen if required
- Clothes to change into after the game/s
- A mouthguard
- Headgear (optional)
- Provided uniform (worn).

Parents/carers may also wish to pack a foldout chair.

Sports uniforms will be provided for each child before the day. Please ensure that your child <u>packs a change of clothes</u> so that their uniform can be returned on the day and that he/she wears their AFL Uniform AND a school jumper/jacket (or PSSA Representative Jumper) to the game. Football socks, football boots and mouthguards must be worn, and headgear is recommended. Tackle football will be played on the day.


If there are any cancellations due to weather, I will post such on Facebook. Alternately, I will call you on the number you provide on the Permission Slip.
