Dear Parents/Caregivers,

As you may be aware, at the beginning of this year there was a possibility that we would be forming a K/1 as a result of the number of children in Kindergarten. We have tried to maintain the current groupings for as long as possible, but as more children have enrolled at our school, our Kindergarten classes have grown to a size that is not optimal. As a result, and after long and careful consideration among the K-2 team, we have decided to reform classes to make 2 straight kindergarten classes, a K/1 and a straight Year 1 class. This will ensure students' educational and social needs are being better catered for. As a result, a small group of children will be changing classes. If your child has been identified as one of the children to move, you would have been contacted by their current class teacher. These changes will happen on Thursday, 1 August, 2019.

The teachers are as follows: KS - Mrs Beth Smith; KV - Mrs Jodi Vaughan; K/1S - Mrs Jenni Smith; 1H - Miss Chloe Hearn

Specific kindergarten and Year 1 activities such as sport, musical performances, excursions etc will still occur and those children will re-join kindergarten for those times.
