



Year 5 Jindabyne Camp Confirmation Note

Dear Parent/Guardian,

At this stage we have had 28 students of 50 pay their \$100 deposit or more for the Year 5 Excursion. This excursion is a memorable part of each child's learning experience and it links to the curriculum. Classes will not operate for those not attending, students will have set work they are expected to complete in other classes within the school, should they not attend. The excursion will still be taking place at this stage, despite the low numbers of those currently paid to attend. If deposits are not up to date for more students by the next instalment, the excursion may not take place.

- Paid the full \$320 for the 2019 Year 5 Camp and has a confirmed place*.
- Paid their full \$100 excursion deposit and has a confirmed place on the 2019 Year 5 Camp*. Please ensure that the following instalments are made on time to retain your child's place on the excursion (*INSTALLMENTS DUE: \$100 by Friday 28th June (Week 9 Term 2) and \$120 by Friday 18th October*). Failure to make instalments on time may result in your child being placed on a wait list/withdrawn.
- Only paid _____ of the required \$100 deposit. Please contact me at school before the end of term to discuss your child's attendance at the excursion.
- Not paid any of the required \$100 deposit. They will not be attending the excursion. Please contact me at school before the end of term if you would like to discuss this matter.

*Confirmations may be with drawn if:

- (a) The excursion is cancelled due to low numbers;
- (b) Your child is withdrawn from the excursion due to illness/behaviour (this may result in them forfeiting their \$100 deposit).

If the excursion is cancelled or a student is withdrawn, parents/carers who made the initial payment will receive a refund form. Funds will then be returned to a nominated bank account within 20 business days.
