### School Service

The wreaths will then be taken down to the memorial on Beach Street following the service. A special morning tea will be held in the staffroom after the event. Guests are welcome to attend.

### Pambula Service

This year our school has been invited by the Merimbula RSL to march at the Pambula town service. Students are to muster at the front of Foodworks at 8.30am for a 9am service. Our School Leaders, Emily Watkins and Malachi Mills-Hindle, will be speaking at this service. Malachi will be a flag bearer at the front of the march. Our SRC will also lay a wreath. Our choir will be performing 4 songs.

### Merimbula Service

The Merimbula RSL has again invited our students to represent the school and be part of the 2016 Merimbula ANZAC Day Ceremony. As in recent years a Dawn Service will take place in Beach Street Merimbula at 5.45am for a 6.00am service.

Our students have been invited to march at the 11.00am service. Students are to muster at the front of the Merimbula RSL on Main Street at 10.30am (10.15am for SRC Leaders), ready to march at 11am to the memorial on Beach Street. Our School Leaders, Kalarni Ackling and Calissa Badulloovich, will be speaking at this service. Malachi will be a flag bearer at the front of the march. Our SRC will also lay a wreath. Our choir will be performing 4 songs.

### **Students who are marching:**

- May wear commemorative medals belonging to family members but they must wear them on the right side of their chest (only veterans/soldiers wear them on their heart/left).
- May wear rosemary. Some is given out at the RSL.
- Should bring a hat, or in inclement weather an umbrella.
