Parents/Carers are required to organise transport for their child to and from Bournda National Park. The day will begin at 10am on Monday and conclude at 2:30pm on Wednesday. Students will be met by Bournda Environmental Education staff at the field study huts (see attached map) on the Monday morning. Please see the attached program for more information about the camp.

Children will need to provide their own lunch, recess and afternoon tea for the first day (Monday). They will also need to bring a water bottle and hat.
