Clean Up Australia Day

Dear Parents/Caregivers/Grandparents,

Schools Clean Up Day for Merimbula Public will be held on Friday 3rd March 2017. We will once again be supporting "Clean up Australia Day" by cleaning up designated areas, either within the school grounds or the school surrounds.

Students from **Kindergarten, FL, FM and FB** will **clean up the school grounds**, while **Stage 1** will clean **Spencer Park**, **Stage 2 – Randolph and Munn Street** and **Stage 3 – Beach Street**.

Stage teachers will **decide on the day, a convenient time** for their clean up. Students will be asked to provide protective **gardening gloves** to handle rubbish, **wear sunscreen (children are to bring their own) and a hat**. Any student with a diagnosed medical condition should inform their class teacher. Students diagnosed as being at risk of anaphylaxis should bring their adrenaline auto-injector (Epipen) with them on the day. Children will also be responsible for carrying their own asthma puffers.

Safety is important, so all students should follow instructions, be responsible and well behaved, especially those around water. Students will also be briefed about the importance of hazardous materials and informed that they will not pick up these items, but alert supervising teachers.
