## **Stage 1 Dinosaurs Talking and Listening task**



As part of our unit of work this term we are learning about living things with a focus on dinosaurs. To compliment our learning we are asking all students to present a 'Design and Make' task to the class in Weeks 7 and 8 on their usual news day.

Students are requested to make a model of their favourite dinosaur. It could be made from any material that they like. We encourage the use of reusable or recycled materials. They will be required to present a speech to the class that has been prepared at home. The speech will need to include:

- The type of dinosaur they have made and it's name.
- A minimum of 3 facts about their dinosaur.
- How they made their dinosaur.
- What materials they used to make it.

Some ideas include: clay, paper mache', Lego, pipes, wooden bones, leftover meat bones, wood, plasticine or Fimo (modelling clay) or any random materials you have lying around the home that can be reused. We have had some awesome dinosaurs in past years and really look forward to seeing what the students come up with!

These models will then be displayed in classrooms at our 'Dinosaur Museum' This is an exciting open classroom session where you will be invited in to see what all of the students in Stage 1 have made. Our Dinosaur Museum will take place on Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> of June between 12.30 and 1.25pm.
