Program dates are as follows:

Term 4: Weeks 4, 6, 7, 8 and 9 (Friday November 4, 18 and 25; Friday December 2 and Thursday December 8). There is no elective sport in Week 5 due to Stage 3 Camp.

Options: The sports on offer are listed in the following tables. Students are encouraged to discuss the options, payment and requirements with their parents prior to seeking permission to nominate their selections. Please assist your child to make their selections and **return the attached page to school by Friday 21st October**.

Students are to **select 5 sports** they would like to participate in for each program, **numbering them 1** to 5, with number 1 being your first choice.

Payment: Students will be invoiced in Week 3, based on the programs they are timetabled to participate in. **Full payment** will need to be paid by **Monday 31st October (Week 4 Term 4)** for students to be guaranteed a place in the program. **Unfortunately, no refunds can be made if your child is unable to attend their chosen sport on any given Friday.**

Times: Students leaving the school grounds will be escorted by the supervising teacher at 9:45am and will return to school at lunch time, 11.15am.

Notification of Your Child's Program: You will be notified by Monday 24th October of the sport that your child will be participating in.
