

## Stage 2 and 3 Elective Sports Program Term 4 - 2017

Friday, August 25<sup>th</sup> 2017

Dear Parent / Carer / Grandparent,

During Term 4, all children in Stages 2 and 3 will be participating in a 5 Week Elective Sports Program. Program dates are as follows:

*Term 4: Weeks 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 (Thursday, October 19<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> and November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>).*

**Options:** The sports on offer are listed in the following table. Students are encouraged to discuss the options, payment and requirements with their parents prior to seeking permission to nominate their selections. Please assist your child to make their selections and **return the attached page to your child's class teacher, or the 'post box' in the office, by Monday, September 4<sup>th</sup> 2017.**

Students are to select 5 sports they would like to participate in for each program, numbering them 1 to 5, with number 1 being your first choice.

**Payment:** Students will be invoiced in Week 9 (Term 3) based on the program they are timetabled to participate in. **Do NOT send in payment with the expression of interest** as sports will need to be allocated based on availability of places. Full payment will need to be paid by Friday, October 13<sup>th</sup> 2017 (Week 1, Term 4) for students to be guaranteed a place in the program. Unfortunately, **no refunds** can be made if your child is unable to attend their chosen sport on any given Thursday.

**Times:** Students leaving the school grounds will be escorted by the supervising teacher at 11.45am and will return to school by recess at 1.40pm (slightly different for Lawn Bowls).

**Notification of Your Child's Program:** You will be notified in Week 9 (Term 3) of the sport that your child will be participating in.

**Code of Conduct:** In accord with the school's Discipline Policy, students on Behaviour Monitoring, or those who have been suspended within 10 weeks, are not able to attend off-site activities. If your child has been suspended or is on monitoring, please ensure that their choices are on site. If a child is suspended or goes onto monitoring during the course of the program, they will not be refunded should the activity has a cost. In addition, staff will place your child within an on-site activity that has not reached capacity. School rules are to be followed in all activities.

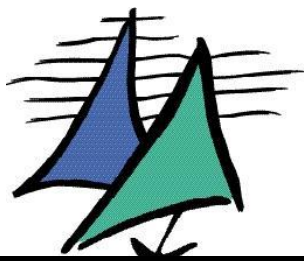
