Ethics Classes at Merimbula Public School

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Ethics classes are available in NSW public primary schools as an option for children who do not attend Special Religious Education (SRE) / Scripture.

The NSW government has authorised Primary Ethics, a not-for profit organisation, to design curriculum and provide school communities with training and support to establish and maintain classes in their schools.

The curriculum comprises a wide range of age appropriate topics that primary-aged children find interesting. Classes are inquiry-based and children use dialogue and discussion to learn how to think about ethical matters through the give-and-take of reasoned argument.

Ethics classes for Stage 1, Stage 2 and Stage 3 will be offered at Merimbula Public School for ½ an hour every Friday afternoon, from March 4. Stage 2 and 3 classes will take place from 11.55am-12.25pm and Stage 1 classes will be held from 12.55pm-1.25pm.
