Parents Count Too
Helping your child with -
Measuring temperature and time

Children need opportunities to compare two or more things to understand measurement. To understand temperature they need to compare two things to measure the "hotness" or "coldness" of a substance. They need to see and talk about how temperature can affect things as well as the ways we can measure temperature.

Initially, children will learn about time through using language such as yesterday, today and tomorrow and through comparing the time it takes to complete activities. I can stop at about twenty seconds while you drive a half in the air and catch it. Later, children will read the time from both digital and analogue clocks.
