Please support your child by applying the following make-up/costuming prior to coming to school for:

Class/Cast	Character	Costume
Kindergarten	Rats	From Home: Grey/black/brown track pants and long sleeve shirts. Provided By School: Mouse ears on headband. Grey cone-nose with pipe cleaner whiskers attached – held on with elastic around back of head.
1S & 1K	Monkeys	From Home: Brown track pants and shirt. Provided By School: Round monkey ears on headband.
2H & 2L	Stars	From Home: Cool coloured pants/t-shirts. Provided By School: Each student holds brightly coloured or silver cardboard stars 20-30cm diameter.
3J/3B, 3/4P, 3S	Natives	From Home: Girls - Tights, grass skirts, coloured crop tops or singlets and lei; and Boys – Board-shorts with Hawaiian shirt and lei.
4C, 4U	Sailors	From Home: White socks, white pants and a white t-shirt (or karate or cricket uniform). Provided By School: Navy blue neck scarf and sailor hats.
5H, 5/6M, 6K & 6B	Pirates	From Home: Traditional red and black with striped tops, knee length trousers, bandanas and striped socks/tights, pirate hats or scarves on head, eye patches and scars.
