



School Music Audition Time !!! - 2017

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Recently Stage 2 and 3 students met in the hall to discuss our 2017 Musical, "The Amazing Adventures of Super Stan"!

The **Amazing Adventures of Super Stan** the musical, Directed by Mrs Candy McVeity, will be our 2017 Whole School Musical Performance. Your child has been informed that every class will have a part in the Musical and that Stage 2 and 3 students will have the opportunity to audition for one of the lead or minor speaking roles next week. Interested children have been given copies of the script this week, ready for auditions.

Students wishing to audition for a lead role MUST be able to fulfil the following responsibilities:

- Have outstanding behaviour (as in accord with our Behaviour Policy, they will miss out-of-hours events/performances if they are on Behaviour Monitoring);
- Attend rehearsals as needed (depending on the part they have been given) **AT THE FOLLOWING TIMES:** *Recess times (as required) 1.40-2.10pm and from 1.40-2.55pm on a Friday afternoon. There may also be some after school rehearsals closer to the performance;*
- Learn and memorise their lines and music;
- Be enthusiastic and demonstrate our school values of Respect, Responsibility and Resilience; and
- Can attend all of the following Dress Rehearsals/Performances:
 - Matinee (Wednesday, September 6, 9-11am),
 - Evening Performances (Monday September 4 and Wednesday September 6, 6pm arrival for a 6.30-8pm show),
 - Dress rehearsals and full run-throughs: Tuesday 29, Wednesday 30 of August and Friday September 1 and 'main-cast' full day rehearsals on August 16 and 23 (Wednesdays).

We are so excited about this new musical opportunity. Students have the opportunity to audition for one of 54 speaking parts. Four of these characters (see attached note) are required to sing solo songs and/or lines. The parts of Lollie King, Gran, Curly, Stanley Marvel, Wurly, Mayor, DC, Superstan, Max Volume, Bernard, Frank and Gloria (who all have over 20 lines and/or solos, may have an understudy who has fewer lines. The understudy may not get to perform the larger role, unless required, however they will have a smaller main part. This option will be revised following auditions.

Closed auditions (not open to parents/all students) will be held recess from Tuesday to Friday next week. Students will also be required to sing a familiar song at the audition. The song will be chosen by Mrs McVeity and shared at the auditions.
