Principal's Messages:

Welcome New Students and Families: Over the last two weeks Mrs Hodsdon and I have been busy showing new families around the school. We have already enrolled 14 new students, in addition to our 52 Kindy students, for 2018! Some have also commenced this week. Welcome new families!

We are very close to requiring an additional teacher and classroom. If you know of any students who are leaving the school, or moving to the area/school, could you please let us know so that we can put plans in place. We are currently forming classes and would love for them to be accurate and ready for the new year.

Kinder Orientation Visit Success: Thank you to all of the families who have supported our Kindergarten Orientation Program. We have enjoyed meeting new families and getting to know so many lovely new children. Thank you to the staff who supported this smooth start.

The formal orientation program has now ended, however we are still lucky to be having visits from some of our students who have been invited to additional sessions. These sessions are taking place over the next four Thursdays from 9.15-11am.

Early Stage 1 (Kindergarten) and Stage 1 (Year 1 and 2) News:

What a busy and exciting term it has been already with lots of wonderful events and opportunities for our students. The year is coming to an end and students are excited about a number of fun and engaging activities we have planned for the remainder of the school year.

Sport: For Sport this term, students have been focusing on a number of Games and Sport skills including basketball and netball skills (throwing and catching), AFL and soccer skills (kicking), cricket and handball (hand-eye coordination). Sport is held on Wednesday afternoons for all students in K-2 on the oval.

Assembly: The final assembly for K-2 this term will be held in Week 7 on 20th November with K/1Y hosting. Thank you to all of the parents that have attended throughout the year.

Swimming Scheme: The scheme will take place for two weeks from **Monday 27**th **November to Friday 8**th **December.** Please note if your child misses a day, a refund will not be possible. Students should wear school uniform and will need to bring a swimming costume, a towel, goggles and a plastic bag for wet swimwear. Please ensure all items of uniform and swimwear are labelled with your child's name and school.

The Department of Education's School Swimming Scheme is an intensive learn to swim program which develops water confidence. It provides students with basic skills in water safety and survival. The scheme is conducted over 10 days.

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Each daily lesson is 45 minutes. Instruction will be held at the Sapphire Aquatic Centre, Pambula for students who have paid and returned permission notes to attend. There will be no formal classes for students who are not attending from 12.30pm-3.00pm.

NRL Gala Day: There will be an NRL Gala Day for K-2 in Week 7 on Wednesday 22nd November. This will be held at school on the oval from 11.40-1.40pm. *Please note, this will be in place of normal sport lessons on that day*.

End of Year Party Day: The End of Year Party Day has been organised for Thursday 14th December. Students will watch a G/PG rated movie at the Picture Show Man Cinema before taking part in a disco run by the SRC in the Jackson Hall. A note is being sent home today with this newsletter.
