- Topic is focused and information is selected to argue your position succinctly.
- All parts of your speech are well developed. Defines topic and states position in introduction, detailed longer body develops position and conclusion strongly reiterates position.
- Ideas are generated and selected to be highly persuasive.
- Effectively uses a range of devices with sophistication.
- Meaning is clear and speech flows well.

A draft outline of your speech is due on Friday, November 10 2017 so that I can make sure it is appropriate. Please be ready to deliver your speech to MPS students on Tuesday, November 14 2017 in the Jackson Hall at 11.45am.
