



Stage 3 Homework Task – Term 3

This term in geography, Stage 3 students are exploring the many ways in which Australia connects and interacts with its Asian neighbours.

The homework task for Term 3 will require students to choose and research one country in Asia and display their findings in a method of their own choosing. Some suggested ideas include:

- PowerPoint presentation
- Written report
- Displayed on a large sheet of cardboard
- Filmed news report
- Speech to the class
- Role play

Students are to investigate the Asian country of choice by exploring its geographical characteristics, culture and relationship with Australia. Below is a checklist of what students are asked to include in their findings.

- A map pinpointing the country's geographical location.
- Physical characteristics such as climate, cities, size, flora and fauna etc.
- Human features such as population, lifestyle, employment, education etc. How do these differ from Australia?
- Cultural aspects that could include food, religious beliefs, language, sport
- Australia's connection with the country including sport, trade, tourism, migration, media, aid and support etc.
