
Dear Parents and Caregivers,


We are really excited to be showcasing The *Amazing Adventures of SuperStan*, the musical, to our school community next week! This has been an exciting whole school musical performance to put together, with all students and staff collaborating to share our arts programs and give opportunities for development in the arts. Thank you to Mrs McVeity for coordinating and directing the showcase!

All students are taking part in the musical. We have around 50 students from Years 3-6 in lead roles, with each class/grade performing as our chorus. Thank you to the parents/carers who have assisted children in learning their lines and preparing costumes. Thank you also to the parents, staff and community members who have assisted with props. Thank you in advance for bringing your children in to take part in evening performances.

Evening Performances – Wednesday September 6 and Thursday September 7:

- Students will be required to *arrive at school between* **5.45-6pm** (for the 6.30-8pm show).
- Students will have to be taken to the holding rooms in **full costume** by their parent/carer and have their names marked off. They will also be picked up from this same location at the end of the performance (see Map below for drop off/pick up areas <u>this includes all Main Cast</u>).









- Please ensure that your child has had a healthy snack/meal at home prior to coming back into school.
- As per our Discipline Policy, students on Behaviour Monitoring or who have been suspended within 10
 Weeks, are unable to attend out of school hours activities. Please ask your child's teacher for
 clarification if needed.
- Children are <u>not to play on school grounds</u> before or after the performance. They may bring a book to read while they are in the waiting rooms, otherwise they will have quiet drawing activities and/or a G Rated movie to watch while they are waiting to perform.
- For the evening performances, doors will open at 6pm.
- Audience members with pre-paid tickets (purchased at school or via the online booking system prior to today) are to line up at the table closest to the hall, hand in their tickets, sign the attendance register and get their entry stamp.
- Seating is not allocated therefore, aside of a few reserved seats in the front row, those arriving earliest will get first selection of seats.
- Visitors with wheelchairs, strollers or other support needs are encouraged to contact the school administration office on (02) 64951266 before next Wednesday so that appropriate seating/space can be allocated.
- Tickets must be presented for a seat to be allocated. Toddlers without tickets will need to sit on a parent/carer's lap due to limited seating. Toddlers with tickets are welcome to bring a cushion to sit on.
- If there are remaining tickets (no promises) they will be sold at another table (closest to the canteen) for \$10 on the night (cash only). Check Facebook next week for ticket availability. Online ticket sales close today.
- Attendees purchasing tickets on the night will also need to sign the register at that table, and be stamped prior to entry.
- The school gates closest to the hall, office and oval will be open from 5.30pm.
- The More Than Beans coffee van will be at the school from 5.45pm, selling hot drinks prior to the evening performances.

<u>Maintee Performance – Wednesday September 6:</u>

- Students will be required to arrive at school in full costume. They can wear their costume for the day!
- The matinee will commence at 12pm, with doors opening at 11.40am.
- Only the gate near the front office will be unlocked until 11.40am, but it will be closed. Please close it behind you.
- At 11.40am the gate near the hall will be unlocked (but closed) however the oval gate will be locked. Please give yourself time to walk around the school if parking on that side of the school.
- Again, audience members with pre-paid tickets are to line up at the table closest to the hall, hand in their tickets, sign the attendance register and get their entry stamp.
- Seating is not allocated therefore, aside of a few reserved seats in the front row, those arriving earliest will get first selection of seats.
- Visitors with wheelchairs, strollers or other support needs are encouraged to contact the school administration office on (02) 64951266 before next Wednesday so that appropriate seating/space can be allocated.
- Tickets must be presented for a seat to be allocated. Toddlers without tickets will need to sit on a parent/carer's lap due to limited seating. If this show is not sold out, as it usually does not, then toddlers are welcome to a seat. Toddlers are welcome to bring a cushion to sit on also.
- <u>Remaining</u> tickets will be sold at the table closest to the canteen for \$10 (cash only) and attendees signed in.
