Staff Development Day (SDD)/Pupil Free Day – April 29:

Monday, April 29 (Staff Only): Our staff look forward to learning more about the new curriculum (teaching staff) and how to support students' wellbeing (support staff).

Staff will be attending workshops on site. Our school office will be closed on this day, as all staff will be participating. We also welcome 7 of our local preschool and early childhood educators to Merimbula Public School, who will be joining our staff to complete professional learning on this day.



PSSA Tennis Team: Our talented students played well during their round one game against Pambula PS this week. Unfortunately, the match was ceased due to inclement weather with only 2 of the 8 sets completed. We have rescheduled to complete the remaining sets on Tuesday, May 7. A Compass notification will be provided to families prior to the event.

K-2 Sport - Term 2: During the winter terms (Term 2 and Term 3), the oval can still be wet for a few hours in the morning. As a result, K-2 Sport will be taking place on Tuesdays after recess (1.55-2.55pm) in Term 2 and 3, instead of on Fridays. Sport will return to Friday mornings in Term 4.

Stage 2 Sport: Stage 2 Sport will be taking place on a Friday (12.15 to 1.15pm and 1.55pm-2.55pm) from Week 1, Term 2. Stage 2 sport will no longer be taking place on a Thursday.

Road Henwood Street Works: Reminder that Henwood Street (adjoining the oval / back gate) will be throughout upgraded Term commencing from the first day. Kerb and guttering, new road works and changed parking areas (and signage) will be put in place. At times there may be road closures or traffic delays. If this area becomes dangerous for pedestrians/traffic, our school will temporarily be closing the back access gate.

















We are awaiting further advice from Bega Valley Shire Council, and will advise families of any changes and communications we receive, via Compass.

Following this roadwork project, roads surrounding Henwood Street, such as Collins Street, will then be attended to.

If you use these roads, or your child does on route to/from school, please speak with them about pedestrian safety.


