Ask the school in writing; 2. Meet with school staff to discuss details; 3. The principal considers your request, taking into account the needs of your child, other students and the operations of the school; and 4. The principal lets you know whether or not the provider can deliver their services at the school. Please see the attached information brochure for more information.

Should an external assessment need to be completed for your child, and a related questionnaire/survey required to be completed by your child's class teacher for their therapist/NDIS team, please email our school requesting: 1. That the assessment be completed; 2. The name of the assessment; 3. Who is required to complete the assessment; and 4. Provide the school with a copy of the questionnaire/survey/online link via email. Currently we are receiving many work/questionnaire requests from external providers and we are not at liberty to answer them, for confidentiality reasons, without parental permission via a written request.

## 2024 School Swimming & Water Safety Program:

Children in Year 2 have the opportunity to participate in the Department of Education's School Swimming and Water Safety Program.

The Department of Education School Swimming and Water Safety Program is an intensive learn to swim program, which develops water confidence, providing students with:

- water safety and survival skills for those who have not reached a satisfactory standard, and are unable to swim 25m confidently, unaided, with correct technique in deep water;
- Students who can swim 25m, will continue to develop their skills and proficiency in other strokes through this program.

The program is conducted over ten days, and all students are eligible to participate. Lessons will take place daily, running for 45 minutes.

Further information, consent and payment through Compass Events has been sent to all Year 2 families.
