



## Sapphire Coast Learning Community (SCLC) 2022 Creative Arts Camp

Dear Parents & Carers,

Stage 3 students at Merimbula Public School are given the opportunity to attend the Sapphire Coast Learning Community (SCLC) 2022 CREATIVE ARTS CAMP. The camp will be held between **Monday 4<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> of April, 2022** (Term 1 Week 11) at Kianinny Bush Cabins and the Bega Civic Centre.

The camp is open to students in Year 5 to Year 8 within the Sapphire Coast Learning Community of public schools, with an interest in creative arts. It provides an opportunity to work with experienced teachers and industry professionals to further develop their skills. Workshops include, but are not limited to: dance, drama, physical theatre/circus arts, woodcarving, film making/photography and visual arts.

In 2022, students will have the option to opt into the camp as both residential (overnight) campers and day campers (returning home each evening). This has been done in an effort to provide the opportunity for students from varying circumstances to attend and to alleviate concerns of some parents regarding overnight accommodation in our current COVID world.

Cost for the camp is:

- \$250 - students attending as residential campers
- \$180 - students attending as day campers
