- ➔PLEASE NOTE: We will be staying at Kianniny Cabins on the Monday and Tuesday nights. Students go home on the Wednesday evening (June 1st) and return to the camp program at the Bega Commemorative Civic Centre 9am on Thursday June 2nd. All students are to be picked up from Kianniny Bush Cabins on the evening of Wednesday 1st June at 7pm by parents/carers, unless prior arrangement made with camp staff.
- **Monday night** - High School Talent night (please prepare a performance piece prior to camp).
Tuesday night - Cabin Performances (Student mentors coach students at camp to prepare and present an item)
- At the conclusion of the camp, a concert is to be held in the Bega Commemorative Civic Centre. The concert is expected to commence at 7pm and end by approx. 9.00pm. This performance is free of charge to families and friends of all students attending the camp. Doors will open at 6.30pm. First in best dressed for seating. Students will need to be collected at the conclusion of the camp from Bega Commemorative Civic Centre, after the concert.

- While attending the camp, students will be expected to follow all reasonable directions of Kianinny Bush Cottages and Music Camp staff and peer mentors. The camp is being organised to provide enjoyment and education for all involved, consequently persistent disobedience or behaviour considered as inappropriate according to DEC policy while at camp may lead to expulsion from camp. In these unexpected and extreme circumstances parents will be contacted and asked to collect their child immediately. The school principal would be contacted and further disciplinary action may be imposed.
- Students will be expected to adhere to their school's policies regarding mobile phones and valuables.
- All students need to be signed in to camp by parents or carer. If for any reason students are leaving/returning to camp parents/carers need to sign students in and out with staff member in the Bush Pavillion. All medication to be administered by camp staff is to be handed to Candy McVeity on arrival at camp. All medication needs to be in original packaging. Parents/Carers are required to fill out a medication schedule – provided on arrival.
