<u> "24 Hour Strike/Industrial Action" – Next Thursday, June 30</u>

Dear Parents, Grandparents and Caregivers,

As you are probably aware, the NSW Teachers Federation has called for teachers to take Industrial Action on Thursday, June 30 (next week).

Lessons will not be taking place at Merimbula Public School <u>next Thursday.</u> Our school will be providing MINIMAL SUPERVISION ONLY.

Our organisational structure will look as follows:

- Classes/lessons will not take place on Thursday;
- Our Canteen and Uniform Shop will be CLOSED on Thursday;
- The **Superheroes Award Lunch** will be postponed until Tuesday, July 26 (Week 2) *A new permission note has been sent home today);
- Buses will be operational;
- Students will not be supervised by their usual classroom teacher or within their usual classroom.
- School access will only be available via Randolph Street, the front bus bay/Administration Office gate.
- The **Henwood Street (back oval) gate will be closed** in the morning and afternoon due to greatly reduced supervision;
- Students are required to bring their own stationery/pencil case, a book to read and activities to complete on the day (ie: drawing, a colouring in book);
- <u>Minimal supervision will be provided in the following areas:</u> Years 3 to 6: 4F and 4D Classrooms; Kindy to Year 2: KV and 1M Classrooms; Support: Library;
- Morning supervision (before the bell): Students are to remain seated, ready for roll call at 8.55am, in the following areas: K-2: Lower Covered Outdoor Learning Area; Stage 2 and 3: Upper Covered Outdoor Learning Area/Hall.

What will happen if the school becomes completely non-operational?

Should minimal supervision become unavailable, for instance, if a lot of students attend school next Thursday, or the few teachers attending become unavailable, putting student supervision and safety at risk, *our school may become non-operational.* If this is the case, parents/caregivers will be advised that the school will be non-operational to students. If this does occur before or on Thursday morning, parents/caregivers will be notified via Facebook and School Stream.

<u>Should the school become non-operational on Thursday morning, once student</u> <u>numbers are identified at roll call, parents/caregivers will be required to collect their</u> <u>children</u>. This information will be shared via Facebook, School Stream and via phone calls to parents, carers and/or nominated emergency contacts.
