Students will be provided with a school jersey to wear during the game. They are to wear their sports/school uniform, suitable footwear, and must bring a water bottle, their lunch, morning tea and afternoon tea.

Students will be required to be transported by private vehicle. We have very limited seats for travel with a staff member.

Students travelling with the team are to meet Mrs Donald outside the Merimbula Public School Office at 8.45am on Wednesday, ready to leave school by 9am. Students need to be in Broulee by 11am, to allow for recess and to warm up prior to the game. Students will have lunch after the game, before returning to Merimbula Public School at approximately 3:30pm. Parents/caregivers should be at school at 3.30pm to collect their child. If the team is returning late, we will post an update on our Facebook page.

All students are expected to comply with the Merimbula Public School Sport Code of Conduct when participating in any sporting activities representing the school. If students do not comply with our Code of Conduct, their spot in the team may be forfeited. Additionally, if students are on Behaviour Monitoring at the time of the game, they will be unable to represent the school.
