Play 2 (Lower Flat/COLA/Big Steps)

Learning Intentions

We will know how to respect the rights, views and property of others at playtimes.



Rules and Responsibilities

- K-2 students only (unless mentors organised by duty staff ie billy carts). Students take responsibility for their actions, be safe and in bounds.
- Food scraps go into green waste. Rubbish into lunchboxes/returns home.
- Sit for lunch (10 min). Children ask to go to the toilet during eating time.
- Wash hands/sanitise before & after eating/play/filling water bottles.
- Handball on courts, no walkways/COLA or office areas. Small balls (squares only)/skipping of a morning only. No swapping/trading own toys/cards. Beyblades in Chillout room only. No running under COLA.
- Wait for duty teachers' instructions before playing/going on equipment.
- Hats must be worn Term 1 & 4, or students sit in the COLA.
- Help pack up toys/games before the bell.
- Canteen after eating time. Food eaten, not thrown.
- Billy cart use at teacher's discretion. No playing on rails or steps. Handstands/gymnastics follows Sports Unit policy.

Supervising Teacher Information

- Students are to be supervised at all times (designated teacher for equipment in addition to Play 2 teacher). Staff actively supervise (no talking to staff).
- MPS staff wear a school key/safety lanyard, as well as a hat when outdoors in Term 1 and 4 (as well as ensure students have a hat in Term 1 and 4 also).
- Clear reminders are given for students to follow Rules and Responsibilities as required (ie Walkways are only for walking/Reasons we need a hat).
- Staff wear fluoro vest when on duty. Water bottles/cups with lids are ok.
- Epipen is carried by staff members on eating duties (then handed to their repacement). *Students do not handle/transport epipens.
- Whistles are saved for open spaces (not COLAs/in rooms).



Students receive whole-school playground Dojos for demonstrating appropriate behaviours.

Negative behaviours are recorded on EBS4.



These behaviours are shared immediately with the students' next teacher, and via EBS4 referrals to all Executive, LST, RFF and class teachers of the student.

Health and Safety concerns are reported to the Principal immediately. School Discipline Policy, PBL Matrix and school values are adhered to.
