School Bins and Recycling Stations

Learning Intentions

We will know how to care for ourselves, others and the environment.



Rules and Responsibilities

- Soft plastics and non-recyclable rubbish goes home (students/staff).
- Food scraps go into the green bin at the canteen.
- Wear gloves then wash hands with soap after helping with recycling.
- Waste Warriors sort blue and white buckets, supervised by a teacher.
- Outdoor recycling station containers: Chook bucket, 10c Earn and Return tub (located in COLAs), Canteen waste bin (located in Canteen COLA).
- Classroom recycling station: Green waste, paper recycling.
- Fruit break scraps go into the worm farm container.
- Food waste containers have lids, and are emptied at least weekly (or as required).
- Students otto bins/worm farm/recycling stations are supervised by a teacher.
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• Use the correct bins for the right rubbish!

School Bins/Recycling Supervising Teacher Information

- Students are to be supervised at all times.
- MPS staff wear a school key/safety lanyard, as well as a hat when outdoors in Term 1 and 4 (as well as ensure students have a hat in Term 1 and 4 also).
- Clear expectations are given for students to follow Rules and Responsibilities.
- Staff handle food waste/bins carefully during times of pandemic/outbreak (following Infection Control Procedures/using gloves).
- Waste Warriors coordinator retrieves recycling from playground stations.
- Paper recycling (red)/food scraps (green) are placed in the correct otto bin by students, during lunch/recess. This bin will be located at the front of the Canteen (in the Canteen Supervisor's line of sight) during break times.



Students receive Class Dojos for demonstrating appropriate behaviours. These are allocated by the MPS teacher electronically, or via letting the child's class teacher know of the achievement/s.

Negative behaviours are recorded on EBS4.



These behaviours are shared immediately with the students' next teacher, and via EBS4 referrals to all Executive, LST, RFF and class teachers of the student.

Health and Safety concerns are reported to the Principal immediately. School Discipline Policy, PBL Matrix and school values are adhered to.
