Rules and Responsibilities

- Line up at the door quietly, waiting for a teacher before entering.
- Demonstrate the school values and be sensible when using equipment. Do not move/touch others' equipment.
- Sanitise hands on entry.
- Students remember to take their own stationery.
- Workbooks and activities are completed neatly and with care.
- Desk/floor areas are kept clean and wiped down after use.
- Save food and drinks for break times.
- Chairs are firmly on the ground (no swinging/leaning).
- Students use manners and follow classroom rules.
- Students pack up their workbooks/resources as asked.

Supervising Teacher Information

- See Scripture/SRE information for more details. Room to be cleared/tidy.
- MPS staff wear a school key/safety lanyard. Volunteers sign in and are wearing a lanyard. Cups with lids permitted.
- Clear expectations are given for students to follow Rules and Responsibilities.
- Staff/volunteers to use own laptops/devices/log-in passwords.
- Only adults use remotes, switches, heater controls. A whiteboard is provided.
- Room is locked, lights off, chairs in, tables wiped & windows shut on exiting.



- ▶ Students receive Class Dojos for demonstrating appropriate behaviours. These are allocated by the MPS teacher electronically, or via letting the child's class teacher know of the achievement/s.

Scripture/SRE staff gain approval from the Principal to hand out rewards/prizes etc.

Negative behaviours are recorded on EBS4.



- ▶ These behaviours are shared immediately with the students' next teacher, and via EBS4 referrals to all Executive, LST, RFF and class teachers of the student.

Health and Safety concerns are reported to the Principal immediately.
