Term 3 Stage 2 and 3 Elective Sports Program 2022

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

In Term 3, all children in Stages 2 and 3 will be participating in a 4 Week Elective Sports Program on a Friday from 12.15-2.30pm.

Program dates are as follows:

Term 3: Week 6, 7, 8 and 9 (26th August, 2nd September, 9th September and 16th September)

Options: Students are to select 5 sports they would like to participate in for each program, numbering them 1 to 5, with number 1 being their first choice. The sports on offer are listed on a table on the next page which explain the options, payment and requirements for each sport. Please assist your child to make their selections and return the attached page to school by Wednesday, 10th August.

Payment: Students will be invoiced in Week 5, based on the programs they are timetabled to participate in. Full payment will need to be paid by Friday 19th August (Week 5 Term 3) for students to be guaranteed a place in the program. Unfortunately, no refunds can be made if your child is unable to attend their chosen sport on any given Friday.

Times: Students leaving the school grounds will be escorted by their supervising teacher at 12.15pm and will return to school at around 2.30pm. Students will take their recess with them to be eaten at sport.

Notification of Your Child's Program: We aim to notify each student by Monday 15th August of the sport they will be participating in. There are limited places for each sport.
