Tell Them From Me – Surveys: We Want Your Feedback!

What Is The Tell Them From Me Survey?

The Tell Them From Me (TTFM) student, parent and teacher surveys have been used in NSW public schools since 2013. They provide data on a range of aspects of school life, practices and procedures from the perspectives of students, parents and teachers. This data provides valuable insights that can inform school planning and decision-making.

The TTFM student, parent and teacher surveys are designed to capture students' wellbeing and engagement at school, as well as, a range of experiences and attitudes of the school community toward school practices and procedures.

Who Completes The Survey?

Students in Years 4 to 6 complete these surveys. Our students have completed them this week (September 7 to 9).

In Term 3, schools are able to survey their wider community through the TTFM parent and teacher surveys. Our parent/caregiver survey is now open until the end of this term (Friday, September 23).

What Is The Parent/Caregiver Survey All About?

The parent/caregiver surveys capture opinions about the culture of a school, including how welcoming and supportive the school is. They also provide data on the practices that parents and teachers are employing to support students at home and in the classroom.

Schools can also ask custom questions in order to obtain feedback from their community on specific initiatives or directions that reflect current school priorities.

Our school has asked additional questions regarding: **school uniforms** (hoodie feedback) and pick-**up/drop-off / 'Kiss and drop' options**, *as requested by the P&C*.
