Dear Parents and Caregivers,

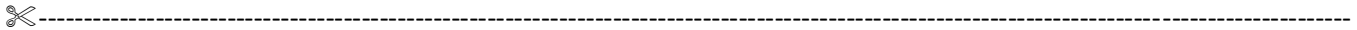

They are also encouraged to bring equipment to help with sand modelling, such as a bucket and spade. They may choose to bring a towel to sit on in the park while eating lunch. Children are allowed to wear full mufti on the day but must wear enclosed footwear, shirts with sleeves and a broad brimmed hat. In the case of inclement weather, the party will be relocated to the classroom where indoor games will be conducted.
