Jackson Cup Years 3-6 2022

Dear Parents, Caregivers and Grandparents,

Our much loved Jackson Cup Soccer and Netball Competition will be taking place again in Term 4 during Stage Sport. Stage 2 will be undertaking the competition on Tuesday from 12.15 and Stage 3 will be competing at the same time on a Friday. Students will participate in a self-selected sport (either soccer or netball) and will play for their house sporting team. Finals for each sport will be held on Friday, 19th November (Week 6). More information about times of the games will be shared on the schools' Facebook page and School Stream when games and times are confirmed. Despite finals being held, the Jackson Cup is about having a go and showing good sportsmanship. Children do not have to be the best player; they are aiming to be the best sport!

All participating students will receive a lemonade icy-twist at the end of the day. Please let your child's teacher know if you do not want your child to receive this.

Students will be required to wear school uniform and their **Sport House Shirt** (Bellbirds: Red, Swans: Yellow, Kookaburras: Green, Pelicans: Blue). If your child has selected to play soccer, **shin pads are compulsory** (but can be borrowed from the school). Football boots ARE NOT permitted. Sports unit guidelines/policy will only allow a child to wear moulded boots if every child has them. Please indicate on the following page if your child has boots, as if all do they may be permitted later in the term for finals matches.

Students should also bring a broad brimmed hat, sunscreen and lots of water on the day that they play. Water bottles can be refilled at our chilled/filtered water stations. Students must not use equipment or wear anything that may cause injury to themselves or other players. All jewellery must be removed.
